Amidst changes to Winter Fuel Payments, Citizens Advice Mid Suffolk offers top tips on affording energy bills this winter.

In late July the Chancellor announced changes to the Winter Fuel Payment (WFP). The WFP is an annual one-off payment to help pensioners pay for heating during the winter. Depending on age and if you live with somebody else who's eligible, it could provide up to £300 towards your bills.

However, the new announcement means only those receiving Pension Credit or other means tested benefits will now be eligible for WFP. The changes might be confusing and worrying to some people who have already factored WFP into their household budget.

#### NOTES FROM THE GARDEN

Hello again. Well summer came; at last the sun was shining on our plants and flowers, showing them off in all their glory, but this also brought challenges with watering in the really hot days. These hot summer days seem to happen more than ever, is the climate changing?

As the seasons change we as gardeners have to adapt accordingly, by planting more drought resistant plants. Mulch more around the garden and create a corner of the garden into a shady area with a small pond or shallow pool. Construct a simple trellis around this with pallet wood cut to size, up this grow climbing plants giving shade underneath to plants such as ferns and Hosta's. With seasons changing winters seem less harsh, which enables us to grow and keep more tender plants giving more scope nature tends to adapt with a little help from us.

As I write this piece Autumn is upon us, a wonderful time of the year, harvesting our vegetables from our allotment, with more to come later. Flowers and plants are slowly preparing for the coming cooler weather ahead. Help them by mulching over them with compost, if the soil is dry give it one last soak. When plants are dormant it is a good time to relocate or divide them. Also in October and November it is not too late to plant daffodils or tulip bulbs. Plant the tulips deeper so they get more moisture in the spring,

November is a time for tidying up the in the garden, clean greenhouse glass and structure trim and tie climbing plants for the winter. If you build a bonfire please turn it over, or relocate it before lighting so as to protect hedgehogs and other small mammals which had made it their winter home.

Keep your bird feeding stations and tables topped up, with clean fresh water available, so our garden birds can be ready to help us next year.

Answer – Yes, one of which is The BenefitsGuide.co.uk. This is a free to use resource which provides clear and comprehensive information on all available UK welfare benefits. This includes guidance on benefit applications, appeals, emergency assistance & legal help. It has been estimated that up to £20 billion of welfare benefits go unclaimed every year in the UK so it is worth checking.
